## **VISION:**


A well developed society where every person has equal rights and better life irrespective of caste, creed, religion and gender.


In the year 2021-22 we have conducted various act activities to empower the women.

For the overall development of the women in various aspects we conducts awareness seminars on regular bases. Various topics related to women are discussed in the said seminars


In the year 2021-22 we conducted Annual Meet Program for rural women where more than 100 women participated and benefitted by the program.

Dignitaries and resource persons detailing on various issues related to women, women role & participation in social development




## Skill Development and Capacity Building Training:

### Sewing training








### Beauty Parlour:




## CHILD DEVELOPMENT :


Our organization often organize some creative activities to motivate rural and tribal children. In the year 2021-22 we have organized following activities ;






## YOUTH DEVELOPMENT :






**Generate awareness regarding Agriculture Sector, Farming and its allied sector Dairy Development.**

Our organization plays an important role in supporting the most vulnerable children access their Right to Education through innovative ideas such as forming student groups and child-tracking systems, holding awareness workshops with parents to ensure that they send children to school.

### **OTHER SOCIAL WELFARE ACTIVITIES:**


For the well being of the society, we organize different and useful programs in urban rural and tribal areas. During the year 2021-22 we have conducted following activities ;
