

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT:

India, a country known for its rich cultural heritage, has long been grappling with gender inequality. However, in recent years, there has been a remarkable shift toward women's empowerment, as the nation recognizes the invaluable role women play in its development. Through various initiatives and policy changes, India is striving to create an environment where women can thrive and contribute to the nation's progress.

Over the past decade, India has witnessed a significant increase in the participation of women in various sectors, including politics, business, and education. The government has implemented policies to ensure that women have equal access to opportunities and resources, promoting gender equality as a fundamental principle. Campaigns such as "Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao" (Save the Girl Child, Educate the Girl Child) have been launched to address issues like female infanticide, child marriage, and limited access to education.

The lack of proper medical facilities and trained professionals exacerbates the health risks faced by women and their children. Maternal mortality rates in these regions remain alarmingly high, with preventable complications contributing to a significant number of deaths.

Women's empowerment is a crucial aspect of achieving sustainable development in any society. In rural areas, where women often face multiple challenges and are marginalized, empowering them can have a transformative impact on communities. This essay aims to analyze the progress and challenges of women empowerment in rural areas of Gujarat State, India.

Gujarat State has made significant progress in women's empowerment over the years. The state government has implemented various policies and initiatives to uplift rural women and promote gender equality. As well as On February 2nd, a program was organized by the organization at Ananda Global School, Vejalpur to aware and educate women about the various schemes run by the Govt.



Employment and Income generation activities:

Poor women's home industries in farsan making offer a means of livelihood to disadvantaged women and their families. By engaging in these activities, these women can generate income to meet their basic needs, such as food, clothing, and shelter. The flexibility of working from home allows them to balance their household responsibilities, including childcare while earning a living. This economic empowerment contributes to poverty reduction and improves the overall living standards of these women and their households.

With the kind help of Shri Ajitsinhji Chauhan, a great order of food packets during the Gujarat Assembly Election Campaign was obtained by the Mahila Guh Udhyog, managed by the Prerna Jyot Charitable Trust.



Skill Development and Capacity Building Training (Beauty Parlour)

In recent years, the beauty industry has witnessed significant growth and has become a key contributor to the economy of Gujarat state. While urban areas have seen a surge in beauty parlors and salons, rural areas have been left behind in this trend. It is crucial to establish beauty parlor training programs in rural areas of Gujarat to empower local women, promote economic growth, and bridge the urban-rural divide.

Firstly, providing beauty parlor training to women in rural areas can empower them by enhancing their skills and self-confidence. Many women in rural areas face limited employment opportunities and are often confined to traditional roles. By equipping them with the necessary skills to become beauty parlor professionals, they can gain financial independence and contribute to their household income. This empowerment can also lead to a greater sense of self-worth and empowerment, as they become active participants in their communities.



In the year 2022-23, we have organized small training at Koth village of Dholka taluka of district Ahmedabad for women to become beauty parlor professionals.



HEALTH RELATED ACTIVITIES :

The health of rural populations in Gujarat has long been a concern due to various challenges faced by these communities. This essay aims to shed light on the health issues faced by rural people in Gujarat and analyze the underlying causes and potential solutions.

One of the primary challenges faced by rural people in Gujarat is the limited accessibility to healthcare facilities. Rural areas often lack proper healthcare infrastructure, including hospitals, clinics, and qualified medical professionals. This leads to delayed or inadequate treatment for various health conditions, resulting in poorer health outcomes for rural populations.

Another significant factor contributing to the health challenges faced by rural people in Gujarat is the lack of awareness and education regarding preventive healthcare practices. Many rural communities lack access to proper health education, leading to a lack of understanding about the importance of hygiene, sanitation, and regular health check-ups. This lack of awareness further exacerbates the prevalence of unhealthy environments and various causes for decreases in the rural sector.

During the year 2022-23, our organization conducted 2 health/medical camps and 1 vaccination camp in rural areas as well as marginal areas in the urban sector to provide health services to the local people.

(1) A free health diagnoses and health checkup camp was organized at the Avadhपुरi Society of Ahmedabad and its surrounding areas. More than 60 people benefitted from the said program.

These notebooks serve as essential tools, enabling them to enhance their skills, document crucial patient information, facilitate communication, and improve healthcare outcomes. With organized records and knowledge retention, these health workers can deliver more efficient and effective care.

It is a small act that yields significant benefits, enabling female health workers to make a meaningful difference in the lives of those they serve.



Blanket and Cloth Distribution to poor :

During the winter season, the free distribution of blankets and warm clothes to poor people is a compassionate endeavor that provides much-needed warmth and comfort. Food Distribution:

This initiative not only provides immediate relief but also prevents waterborne diseases and improves living conditions. By ensuring access to durable and cost-effective shelters during the monsoons, tarpaulin distribution offers vulnerable communities the assurance of protection and hope amid challenging weather conditions.

With the kind support of the Avadhpuri Volunteers Team, we distributed 100 tarpaulins in slum areas of Ahmedabad city and its surrounding.



Prasad Distribution:

In the holy month of Shraavan, the prasad distribution of Sabudana Khichdi, a popular fasting dish, is done by the organization with the kind support of the Delux Group and Avadhपुरi team.
