

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT:

However, recent years have seen a significant shift towards empowering women, as the nation recognizes their crucial role in development. Various initiatives and policy changes aim to create an environment where women can thrive and contribute to the nation's progress.

Over the past decade, women's participation in politics, business, and education has notably increased. The lack of proper medical facilities and trained professionals exacerbates health risks for women and their children. Maternal mortality rates in these regions remain alarmingly high, with preventable complications contributing to many deaths.

In rural areas, where women face multiple challenges and are often marginalized, empowerment can have a transformative impact on communities. This essay aims to analyze the progress and challenges of women's empowerment in rural areas of Gujarat State, India.

Awareness Generation regarding Government Schemes for Women:

Employment and Income Generation Activities: Skill Development and Capacity Building Training

In recent years, the beauty and sewing industries have experienced substantial growth and have become vital contributors to the economy of Gujarat. While urban areas have witnessed a proliferation of beauty parlors, salons, and sewing workshops, rural regions have not kept pace. Establishing beauty parlors and sewing training programs in these rural areas is essential to empower local women, drive economic development, and narrow the urban-rural divide.

Offering beauty parlor and sewing training to women in rural areas can enhance their skills and boost their self-confidence. Many women in these areas face limited employment opportunities and are often restricted to traditional roles. By providing them with the necessary skills to become beauty parlor professionals and proficient seamstresses, they can achieve financial independence and contribute to their household income. This empowerment also fosters a greater sense of self-worth as they become active, contributing members of their communities.

In the year 2023-24, we conducted a series of training sessions across multiple villages in Gujarat to help women become beauty parlor professionals and skilled seamstresses.

Under the initiative of Prerna Jyot Charitable Trust, a workshop on sewing and beauty parlor classes was held in Koth village to make women self-reliant. The women participated enthusiastically in large numbers, demonstrating their eagerness to learn and grow. To further motivate them, we

visited the sewing and beauty parlor classes and encouraged the participants. The impact has been profound, with more women joining each day.

Additionally, Prerna Jyot Charitable Trust organized a Rakhi-making workshop in Shailesh Park Society of Vejalpur ward, led by Smt. Swituben, where women were taught how to make Rakhis and were provided with work. This initiative saw the involvement of Mahila Morcha President Smt. Varshaben Mehta and Mahila Morcha General Secretary Smt. Parulben Makwana, who supported and motivated the participants.

In Koth village, the sewing classes conducted by Prerna Jyot Charitable Trust have seen a significant increase in participation. Women are joining in greater numbers every day, indicating the success and positive impact of these initiatives. The trust remains committed to its mission of empowering women and fostering economic growth in rural Gujarat.
